

Meri Squares was formed in September 1969 when new caller couple Bob and Lise Desrosiers and four couples started dancing at MERIvale High School. An Executive was elected for the 1970-71 dance season. Caller Ross (Margaret) Hoople was engaged beginning with the 1971-72 season. Meri Squares commenced Plus dancing in 1980.

Over the past 50 years, Meri Squares has moved locations several times and has danced at the following venues: Merivale High School (1969-1977); J.S. Woodsworth Secondary School (1977-1984); Sir Guy Carleton Secondary School (1984-1985); J.H. Putnam Public School (1985-1996 with the Plus group at Agincourt Public School 1988-1996); St. Peter's Anglican Church Hall (1996-1999); St. Martin's Anglican Church Hall (1999-2003); Westminster Presbyterian Church Hall (2003-present). Since September 2003, the Basic dancers and the Mainstream dancers have danced in separate halls on Tuesday evenings. The Plus dancers have danced on Thursday evenings.

At the Meri Squares' *Silver Swing* 25th Anniversary dance the club's original banner was retired and the current banner and badge were created – burgundy with white graphics. For over 25 years, the Meri Squares and its members have supported The Snowsuit Fund - at our Christmas dinner/dance the Mitten Tree has been decorated with knitted items and cash donations. Other charitable organizations supported over the years include the Heart and Stroke Foundation and the Westboro Food Bank.
